Beavers Make Noise

Beavers use sharp teeth to cut down trees that 9 fall with a loud noise. Then, beavers use the trees 19 to build dams and lodges. 24 Beavers have a choice. They will pick a stream 33 that is not deep. Beavers make a dam with sticks 43 and stones. They use mud, or wet soil. The stream 53 flows toward the dam. The water forms a deep 62 pond in the back of the dam.

Beavers pick a spot in the pond. Then, they hoist 79 branches and logs. They join it all with mud. 88 Beavers form a lodge shaped like a dome. It 97 looks like a toy fort made by a boy. The lodge 108 sticks up above the water. 113

Inside the lodge is a big open space. This is 123 where the beavers live. They swim in and out of 133 the lodge under the water. Beavers feel safest in 142 the water. That is why beavers build dams to 151 make ponds. It is why they build lodges in ponds, 161 162 too.
